

Club V.I.P. Indoor and Outdoor COVID 19 Policies

Our policies and procedures include considerations for the COVID-19 virus. The health and safety of our campers and staff remain our highest priority. We will be constantly monitoring the situation and staying in communication with our state and local health officials. The following CDC and Alameda County Public Health Department guidance is aimed to help ensure we are lowering COVID-19 risk as much as possible while also allowing our campers to participate.

Health Monitoring & Pre-Camp Screening

- Staff and campers will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 prior to entering the building
- Parent/Guardian will need to take their camper's temperature before coming to the facility and will be asked to confirm that the camper does not have a fever upon arrival
- Staff will perform a visual inspection of the camper for signs of illness
- Staff and campers should stay home when they are sick
- Staff and campers must stay vigilant for symptoms and communicate immediately should they start to feel sick

Drop-Off

- Arrive 10-15 minutes prior to your scheduled session time
- Wait in your vehicle until promoted by staff to proceed to the entrance

- Arrival times for each group will be staggered to limit contact with other campers
- Designated entrances for the schedule session will be communicated prior to arrival
- Staff and campers will be screened upon arrival
- Staff and campers will wash or sanitize their hands before entering the playing area
- Parents, guardians or any additional spectators will not be permitted to enter the building

Operations & Procedures

- Campers will be assigned to stable groups consisting of 12 campers or fewer
- Campers shall not change from one group to another and shall not mix
- Each group will be assigned a designated entrance, exit and playing area
- Campers must bring their own water bottle, snacks and any additional personal belongings needed for the session
- All staff and campers will engage in hand hygiene at the following times:
 - Arrival to the facility
 - After touching frequently touched surfaces
 - After using common items
 - After using the restroom
 - After coughing, sneezing or blowing their nose

- Staff and campers should cover coughs and sneezes with sleeve, elbow or tissue
- Unnecessary physical contact, such as high-fives and huddles will be discouraged

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- Staff should wear a cloth face covering over their nose and mouth
 - Campers should engage in physical distancing while not actively engaged in play
 - Staff will be responsible for handling all training equipment

Pick Up

- Designated pick up locations will be communicated in advance
- Campers will be released immediately when the session is over and asked to exit the facility

Cleaning & Disinfecting Protocol

- Playing area will be cleaned, sanitized and disinfected between each group
- Shared equipment will be cleaned, sanitized and disinfected between each use
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned, sanitized and disinfected multiple times daily
- We will be reducing the quantity of shared equipment whenever possible

- We will be maximizing general ventilation by utilizing window and door openings

Communication

- Information will be shared through e-mail and text messaging to all staff, campers and their families
- We encourage families to talk to campers about simple, but effective prevention tips, such as covering coughs and sneezes and washing hands frequently
- Staff and campers should not come to camp and they should notify camp officials immediately if they become sick with COVID-19 symptoms, test positive for COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone with symptoms or confirmed or suspected case
- Campers should notify staff immediately if they are unable to attend a session for any reason

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures

What to do when you arrive:

- Arrive 5-10 minutes prior to scheduled start time
- Come fully dressed with knee pads and shoes on
- Bring your own water bottle
- Check your temperature before arriving
- Wait in your vehicle until promoted by staff to proceed to entrance/court

- Vehicles should drive to drop off location at curbside near entrance or court
- **DROP-OFF LOCATIONS:**
- Court 1 → MAIN ENTRANCE/COURT
- Campers will be released immediately and go directly to their vehicles
- No lingering outside the building/court
- Please be on time
- **PICK-UP LOCATIONS:**
- Court 1 → MAIN ENTRANCE/COURT
